



ALL IN BARREL RACE RULES

WHAT DOES MY ENTRY FEE INCLUDE?

- ★ One stall for four days for one horse
- ★ Truck and trailer parking
- ★ 4 nights at The Orleans Hotel & Casino, Las Vegas (**dates are pre-determined per race**)
- ★ Contestant jacket
- ★ Entry into the ALL IN BARREL RACE. Each race includes two (2) qualifying rounds & Showdown round
- ★ One 60 sec Exhibition

Early Bird Entries are **\$1,495** and End July 31, 2023, at Midnight Central.

Each contestant's first entry into each race is **\$1,495***. Additional entries per contestant into each race are **\$1,195** [which does NOT include hotel and jacket]

Contestants can choose to upgrade their additional entries to the full price to include hotel rooms and a contestant jacket.

*Paid in full or with payment plan before July 31, 2023: **\$1,495**, after July 31: **\$1,595**

PAYMENT PLAN

Payment plan is available and payment amounts are subject to the date of entry.
(Select the payment plan option at checkout on NextGen Rodeo when entering.)

DRAW

Entries will close at the discretion of ALL IN BARREL RACE management.
Our targeted date for releasing the Draw is **Monday Afternoon, November 28, 2023**
(date subject to change)

Please keep in mind, the ALL IN Barrel Race sold out mid-summer in 2022.

[Producer reserves the right to release the pre-draw as soon as after this date subject to issues finalizing the draw.]

RACE FORMAT

****NEW FOR 2023** RACE FORMAT/DRAW**

The two qualifying rounds will be 5D format with ½ second splits. Round 1 runs in draw order. Round 2 runs in REVERSE DRAG order. If you were last on the drag in Round 1, you will be first on the drag in Round 2. Each drag is in reverse order. (Example: Round 1: run number 1-625, Round 2: REVERSE DRAG run number 1-625. If you were 1st in your drag in Round 1, you will be 5th in your drag in Round 2.)

Fifteen (15) different horse/rider combinations from each of the five (5) divisions of the two (2) qualifying rounds will qualify for the Showdown round. A contestant can qualify on unlimited horses for the Showdown round. Each horse/rider combination may qualify for only one Showdown round position.

To qualify for the Showdown round:

- ★ A horse/rider combination must be in the top 15 places in each D in either the first or second qualifying rounds.
- ★ From qualifying round 1: the top 15 places in each D qualify for the Showdown round.

- ★ From qualifying round 2: the top 15 places in each D qualify for the Showdown round.
- ★ If one of the horse/rider combinations in the top 15 were already qualified from round 1, then that combination cannot qualify again in round 2.
- ★ We will drop the duplicate qualifying combination from the round 2 qualifiers, and the next fastest combination in that D will fill the position. This will continue until all 15 qualifying positions in round two are filled OR until there are no more contestants in the corresponding D to fill the qualifying positions – whichever comes first.

- ★ If there is a tie for the fastest time in the top 15, all ties will qualify for the Showdown round up until the fastest 15 places. Should 15th place have one or more ties, all qualifying ties in 15th place will advance to the Showdown round.
- ★ If there are not 30 horse/rider combinations from each qualifying round (15 from round 1 and 15 from round 2), we will not fill the remaining positions.
- ★ A contestant can also qualify for the Showdown round through the BUY BACK ROUND. (See Buy Back Round Rules)

The time in which a contestant qualifies for the Showdown round will determine the contestant's position in the Showdown round draw order.

It is your decision to make each run. Each contestant is responsible for acquiring Showdown round qualification status. The ALL IN BARREL RACE is not liable to inform you of your Showdown round qualification. Showdown round positions will be posted onsite, on Facebook, and at lvbarrelrace.com.

BUY BACK ROUND - \$7,000

Guaranteed Payout

The Buy Back Round will follow the conclusion of Qualifying Round 2 in both ALL IN
Barrel Races. It is an Open 5D with a \$200 entry fee capped to the first 200 entries.

ENTER ON-SITE - CASH ONLY. The Top 4 in each D will receive Showdown Round
positions. The Top 4 in each D will receive a Guaranteed Payout. 1st place will receive \$500,
2nd \$400, 3rd \$300, and 4th \$200. Entries will open at check-in for each race and will close 30
minutes after the conclusion of Qualifying Round 2 if still available. There will be NO
REFUNDS for entries into the Buy Back Round and entries are limited. You must compete on
the same horse that you entered for the ALL IN Barrel Race (You cannot bring in/substitute a
horse that was not already entered.) You will not be allowed to sell your entry. Specific horse
must be designated at the time of Buy Back Entry.

AMERICAN CONTENDER

If you are entered in the American Contender and make the ALL IN Showdown Round, your run in the American Contender will carry over to the Showdown Round for your time. You cannot run twice. Better Barrel Races takes the American Contender entries a week before the event.

SHOWDOWN ROUND RUNNING ORDER AND FORMAT

The Showdown round will be run as a clean slate. It will be a 5D format consisting of up to the top 30 runners from each D from the qualifying rounds, plus the qualifiers from the Buy Back Round. Based on the descriptions in the section above. The Showdown round will be run in qualifying time order, from slowest to the fastest qualifying time. The contestants' draw number is based on their qualifying time.

ALL IN BARREL RACE 2 Showdown Round draw may be adjusted if there are horse/rider combination conflicts due to the American Contender entries.

The Showdown Round draw will be posted 3 hours after the conclusion of the Buy Back Round.

We take the Top 15 in each D from Qualifying Round 1.

We take the Top 15 in each D from Qualifying Round 2.

We take the Top 4 in each D from the Buy Back Round.

INCENTIVES

\$10,000 ADDED HIGH STAKES CHAMPIONSHIP

The \$10,000 Added ALL IN BARREL RACE HIGH STAKES CHAMPIONSHIP race will be held during **Race 1 | December 6-9, 2023 & Race 2 | December 13-17, 2023**. \$10,000 will be added to each HIGH STAKES CHAMPIONSHIP, RACE 1 and RACE 2. You are required to enter the ALL IN BARREL RACE. You will run in conjunction with each round, but the HIGH STAKES CHAMPIONSHIP will be a

featured event both go rounds of each race. Your run will count towards both the current ALL IN BARREL RACE Round and the HIGH STAKES CHAMPIONSHIPS, as well as any sidepots entered.

- ★ Open to any rider or horse
- ★ Entry fee: \$1,000
- ★ Payout: 80%
- ★ Added money: \$10,000
- ★ Format: 3D with half second splits

The \$25,000 Added ALL IN BARREL RACE YOUTH CHAMPIONSHIPS race will be **Race 1 | December 6-9, 2023**. You are required to enter the ALL IN BARREL RACE 1. Your times from each qualifying round in RACE 1 will carry over to the ALL IN BARREL RACE YOUTH CHAMPIONSHIPS.

- ★ Open to any rider who is 18 years of age and younger as of January 1, 2023.
- ★ Entry fee: \$500
- ★ Payout: 80%
- ★ Added money: \$25,000
- ★ Format: 4D with half second splits
- ★ 2 runs with a Final Payout
- ★ The Final Payout is based on your Fastest Qualifying Run from either qualifying rounds – **This is NOT an Average**

Payout Format

Includes \$25,000 added money and 80% of entry fees collected

- Round 1: 20 % of pot
- Round 2: 20% of pot
- Final payout: 60% of pot

\$5,000 ADDED ADULT CHAMPIONSHIP

The \$5,000 Added ALL IN BARREL RACE ADULT CHAMPIONSHIPS race will be **Race 2 | December 13-17, 2023**. You are required to enter the ALL IN BARREL RACE 2. Your times from each qualifying round in RACE 2 will carry over to the ALL IN BARREL RACE ADULT CHAMPIONSHIPS.

- ★ Open to any rider who is 19 - 49 years of age as of January 1, 2023.
- ★ Entry fee: \$350
- ★ Payout: 80%
- ★ Added money: \$5,000
- ★ Format: 4D with half second splits
- ★ 2 Runs with a Final Payout
- ★ The Final Payout is based on your Fastest Qualifying Run from either qualifying rounds - **This is NOT an average**

Includes \$5,000 added money and 80% of entry fees collected

\$5,000 ADDED SENIOR CHAMPIONSHIP

The \$5,000 Added ALL IN BARREL RACE SENIOR CHAMPIONSHIPS race will be **Race 2 | December 13-17, 2023**. You are required to enter the ALL IN BARREL RACE 2. Your times from each qualifying round in RACE 2 will carry over to the ALL IN BARREL RACE SENIOR CHAMPIONSHIPS.

- ★ Open to any rider who is 50 years of age and older as of January 1, 2023.
- ★ Entry fee: \$350
- ★ Payout: 80%
- ★ Added money: \$5,000

- ★ Format: 4D with half second splits
- ★ 2 Runs with a Final Payout
- ★ The Final Payout is based on your Fastest Qualifying Run from either qualifying rounds - **This is NOT an average**

\$5,000 ADDED ALL IN BARREL RACE FUTURITY

The \$5,000 Added ALL IN BARREL RACE FUTURITY will be **Race 2 | December 13-17, 2023**. You are required to enter the ALL IN BARREL RACE 2. Your times from the qualifying rounds in Race 2 will carry over to ALL IN BARREL RACE FUTURITY.

- ★ Open to all horses aged 5 years and under who have not been entered in any barrel racing competition prior to November 15th of the previous year.
- ★ Horses are eligible to compete in the **ALL IN BARREL RACE FUTURITY** for one year
- ★ Entry fee: \$350
- ★ Payout: 80%
- ★ Added money: \$5,000
- ★ Format: 2D with whole second splits
- ★ 2 Runs with a Final Payout
- ★ The Final Payout is based on your Fastest Qualifying Run from either qualifying rounds - **This is NOT an average**

\$5,000 ADDED ALL IN BARREL RACE DERBY

The \$5,000 Added ALL IN BARREL RACE DERBY will be **Race 2 | December 13-17, 2023**. You are required to enter the ALL IN BARREL RACE 2. Your times from the qualifying rounds in race 2 will carry over to the ALL IN BARREL RACE DERBY.

- ★ Open to any horse foaled in 2015 or after
- ★ Horses are eligible to compete in the ALL IN BARREL RACE DERBY for three years
- ★ Entry fee: \$350
- ★ Payout: 80%
- ★ Added money: \$5,000
- ★ Format: 2D with half second splits
- ★ 2 Runs with a Final Payout
- ★ The Final Payout is based on your Fastest Qualifying Run from either qualifying round - **This is NOT an average**

Payout Format

Includes \$5,000 added money and 80% of entry fees collected

- Round 1: 20% of pot

YOUTH SIDE POT

The ALL IN BARREL RACE YOUTH SIDE POT race will be **Race 2 | December 13-17, 2023**. You are required to enter the ALL IN BARREL RACE 2. Your times from each

qualifying round in RACE 2 will carry over to the ALL IN BARREL RACE YOUTH SIDE POT. See complete details below.

- ★ Open to any rider who is 18 years of age and younger as of January 1, 2023.
- ★ Entry fee: \$100
- ★ Payout: 80%
- ★ Format: 4D with half second splits
- ★ 2 runs with a Final Payout
- ★ The Final Payout is based on your Fastest Qualifying Run from either qualifying rounds – **This is NOT an Average**

Payout Format

Includes 80% of entry fees collected

- Round 1: 20% of pot
- Round 2: 20% of pot
- Final payout: 60% of pot

ADULT SIDE POT

The ADULT SIDE POT race will be **Race 1 | December 6-9, 2023**. You are required to enter the ALL IN BARREL RACE 1. Your times from each qualifying round in RACE 1 will carry over to the ALL IN BARREL RACE ADULT SIDE POT. See complete details below:

- ★ Open to any rider who is 19 - 49 years of age as of January 1, 2023.
- ★ Entry fee: \$100
- ★ Payout: 80%
- ★ Format: 4D with half second splits
- ★ 2 Runs with a Final Payout
- ★ The Final Payout is based on your Fastest Qualifying Run from either qualifying rounds - **This is NOT an average**

Payout Format

Includes 80% of entry fees collected

- Round 1: 20% of pot
- Round 2: 20% of pot
- Final payout: 60% of pot

SENIOR SIDE POT

The SENIOR SIDE POT race will be **Race 1 | December 6-9, 2023**. You are required to enter the ALL IN BARREL RACE 1. Your times from each qualifying round in RACE 1 will carry over to the ALL IN BARREL RACE SENIOR SIDE POT.

- ★ Open to any rider who is 50 years of age and older as of January 1, 2023.
- ★ Entry fee: \$100
- ★ Payout: 80%
- ★ Format: 4D with half second splits
- ★ 2 Runs with a Final Payout
- ★ The Final Payout is based on your Fastest Qualifying Run from either qualifying rounds - **This is NOT an average**

Payout Format

Includes 80% of entry fees collected

- Round 1: 20% of pot
- Round 2: 20% of pot
- Final payout: 60% of pot

BOTTOM'S UP PAYOUT

For each qualifying round of RACE 1 and 2, we will pay the last three riders in the 1D, 2D, 3D, and 4D according to this scale:

- Last in each D: \$300
- Second-to-last in each D: \$200
- Third-from-last in each D: \$100

We will not pay out Bottom's Up in the 5D in order to encourage contestants to make their best runs possible.

We will not pay out these monies if the contestant will win money from the guaranteed payout.

AVERAGE

Each ALL IN Barrel Race will include an average buckle award for each average D winner and a guaranteed total payout of \$10,000. The average will be calculated using the contestant's Showdown Round Qualifying time and their Showdown Round time. The average will be a 5D with ½ second splits. Buy Back Round Qualifiers are eligible for Average awards.

EXAMPLE:

Showdown Round Qualifying Time | 16.000

Showdown Round Time | 16.500

Average Time: 16.250

DO YOU ACCEPT LATE ENTRIES?

Entries are limited depending on hotel and stall availability. Entries will close at the discretion of ALL IN BARREL RACE management.

DRAW OUTS

The draw-out deadline is 12:00pm Noon CST on November 1, 2023. ALL DRAW OUTS require a Veterinarian or Doctor Release (for contestant).

Your options are:

- Receive a Refund of 70% of entry fees paid that have been PAID IN FULL. Entry fees that are NOT paid in full are not eligible for any refunds.
- Substitute the Horse or Rider but NOT both.

To draw out, you MUST email your vet or doctor release to info@lvbarrelrace.com before the deadline to receive a refund. Medical releases only apply to contestants. All draw-out requests must be submitted in writing by **12:00pm Noon CST on November 1, 2023.**

After the **November 1, 2023** draw-out deadline, no refunds will be given for any reason, including partial refunds.

Draw-out refunds will be issued as approved and will be issued to the card you paid your entries with.

NO refunds on side-pots.

DUE TO IMPROPER HANDLING OF ENTRY RESALES

Due to a history of improper handling of entry resales by contestants, you may sell your PAID IN FULL entry back to the ALL IN BARREL RACE only.

A 70% refund will be given.

Selling ANY PART of your entry to another contestant is PROHIBITED and will not be honored, and is subject to disqualification.

SUBSTITUTIONS

Horse or Rider Substitution

Horse changes must be done at check-in of each race or online prior to the Draw.

Horse change must be done prior to the numbering at the event.

After the draws are posted, horse and rider changes can be made onsite at contestant check-in for each race. You may substitute for a different horse, but if the horse/rider combination is already entered you cannot change your draw position. A horse can only be entered one time in each ALL IN Race. Horse or rider substitutions must be made with the contestant's office before the horse is numbered. A form will be available in the office to process the change. Once a horse substitution has been made, that horse must be ridden throughout the Showdown round for that race.

Once a rider substitution has been made, that is the only rider for that horse throughout the Showdown round for that race.

If a horse and rider combination runs out of turn you will be disqualified.

A contestant may NOT change both horse and rider for an entry.

DRESS CODE

Full dress code is required for all races. All contestants must wear a long-sleeved button-up collared shirt, long pants, a western hat or helmet, and cowboy boots or equestrian sports shoes. Contestants may wear any and all individual sponsors. **\$10 Hat Fine.**

CHECK-IN

There are three different check-ins for each race:

- ★ **Stalls** - you may check in to your stalls, in accordance with the time and dates allowed for each race. You will present your Coggins and health certificates at stall check-in or online as directed.

- ★ **Horse numbering** - during the designated hours for each race, your horse must be numbered. If you are substituting a horse, you must make the horse change with the contestant's office prior to numbering.

★ **Contestant** - during the designated hours for each race, each contestant must check in with the office for contestant photographs and to receive contestant packets.

Please have Coggins, Health Papers, & Registration Papers (Futurity and Derby) available at Check-in.

[Digital Papers will be accepted also.]

CHECK-OUT

You MUST be out of your stalls by 10AM on the designated check-out day. Fines will be given to any contestant who's stalls are still occupied after that point.

DO I NEED TO CHECK IN PRIOR TO MY RUN?

You will need to check in with the gate man and be in the holding area with five horses before your run. Failure to do so will result in disqualification. The gateman will be located next to the alleyway going into the arena. The contestant's name will be called by the gateman three times, if the contestant is not in the arena by the third call, they will be disqualified. Only one horse may be in the alleyway at any time. Remember - the three official calls come from the gate man, not the announcer.

EXHIBITIONS

60 Second time limit. You will be fined \$200 if you exceed your 60 second limit.

Each entry comes with one (1) exhibition. You may only use one exhibition per horse entered.

Exhibitions will be first come, first serve. Horses must be numbered prior to taking your exhibition.

Any pushing horses into others, excessively crowding in tight areas, or using foul language towards other contestants or staff will not be tolerated.

OTHER GENERAL RULES

SPORTSMANSHIP

All contestants and their family members are expected to display good sportsmanship at all times. No level of abuse toward any animal at this event will be allowed. Foul language, misconduct, or abusive comments spoken to any contestant, spectator, staff member, or arena personnel will result in immediate contestant disqualification and no refund of entry fees. Contestants are also responsible for traveling companions and their family members.

PHOTOS AND VIDEOS

ALL IN BARREL RACE, LLC and its affiliates, Group W Productions, LLC, and The Orleans Arena, photographs and videotapes each contestant's individual run. These photos/videos are the property of ALL IN BARREL RACE, LLC and its affiliates, Group W Productions, LLC, and decisions made by ALL IN BARREL RACE, LLC management as a result of viewing photos and/or video are final.

By entering you consent to the use of your image and/or likeness of your run and participation for the promotion of the ALL IN BARREL RACE, ALL IN BARREL RACE, LLC, and Group W Productions for any and all future use. NO OUTSIDE photographers or cameras allowed during the ALL IN Barrel Race, LLC.

RETURNED CHECKS

There is a \$35.00 service charge on all returned checks from the bank, for any reason. If a check is not replaced with a cashier's check or money order within 30 days after the check is dated, the contestant will be put on the ineligible list.

DOGS

No dogs are allowed on arena grounds, which includes stall housing, trailer parking, or within the arena facility. Only service dogs with proper documentation will be allowed on the premises. Service dogs must be leashed and under the direct control of the owner at all times. Any owner whose dog is exhibiting disruptive behavior including, but not limited to barking, growling, or aggressive behavior, will be asked to remove the dog from the property by The

Orleans Security. This rule derives from The Orleans Arena policy manual and will be enforced by The Orleans Security.

VENDORS

Vendor forms can be requested by emailing info@lvbarrelrace.com. Selling any type of merchandise or professional service on the arena grounds, in stalls, or at trailers without a vendor contract with ALL IN BARREL RACE or Group W Productions is prohibited.

TIME BEGINS

Any time a contestant crosses the starting line, the time will begin.

NO TIME

A no time will be given to the contestant for the following reasons:

1. If the contestant circles their horse after entering or exiting the arena. The arena area begins once you enter the mouth of the arena from the alley. Repositioning or circling is allowed prior to entering the arena from the alley.
2. If the contestant breaks or misses the barrel pattern.
3. If the contestant or horse rider combo runs out of turn in any ALL IN Class they will be disqualified. It is the contestant's responsibility to know their draw position and horse combo.
4. If a contestant knocks over a barrel. No time will also be given if a barrel is knocked over and it sets up again on either end. Touching a barrel, including keeping it from falling, is permitted without penalty.
5. If the contest's horse falls during the run in such a manner as to break the pattern, or if the rider falls off the horse after entering past the plane of the alley
6. If the contestant is unable to get a horse in the arena within a 60-second time limit.
7. If a horse stops forward motion.

TIME LIMIT

If a contestant is in the holding pen and attempts to enter the arena, but is unable to get the horse down the alleyway, then the gate man, after the second call, will give the rider 60 seconds to enter the arena. At the end of 60 seconds, if the horse has not broken the plane at the end of

the alleyway into the arena, then the rider will be disqualified. (The reason for this rule is the safety of the contestant, the other contestants in the holding area, and the arena personnel.)

BARREL MOVED

If a barrel moved off its marker during competition, the barrel must be reset prior to the next competitor's run.

HORSE AND RIDER RULE

Contestants may run any horse, regardless of ownership, but horses can only be entered 1 time in each ALL IN race.

HORSES IN ARENA/ALLEY

Only one horse may be in the arena, or alleyway, at any time during the competition. (The reason for this rule is the safety of the contestant. Accidents can occur where the assisting horse gets in front of the contestant horse and the contestant horse then decides to go and runs into the assisting horse.)

A horse can be assisted to the mouth of the alley, but persons on foot are not allowed in the alley or the arena once the horse and rider have entered. The gateman will enforce these rules implicitly.

RE-RUNS

Re-runs shall be granted if the official and backup timers both fail to work properly unless a barrel has been turned over resulting in no time. If the barrels are not placed properly on their markers, a rerun shall also be granted without any penalties being applied; however, any penalty occurring on the rerun shall result in no time.

TRAINING IN ARENA

Contestants who are given no time, either for breaking the pattern or for knocking down a barrel, may complete the pattern. However, show management may, at its discretion, ask a rider who is taking excessive time to train to leave the arena immediately.

FASTEST RUN POSSIBLE

Contestants must attempt to make the fastest run possible. Any obvious attempt to pull up or pace their run may result in the following penalties- 1st offense - Warning, 2nd offense - \$50 fine, 3rd offense – placed on the ineligible list for future ALL IN BARREL RACE events.

TIE FOR PRIZES

If any contestants' times are tied, the prize money will be split equally. We will flip a coin to determine who wins prizes.

PAYOUT REQUIREMENTS

To receive your winnings, a completed W-9 must be submitted at check-in, or the payout will be delayed or even forfeited.

Different documents may be required for non-U.S.A. citizens. Prizes will not be mailed.

FINES

Fines must be paid prior to collecting winnings.

DISQUALIFICATIONS

Any act deemed prejudicial to the best interests of ALL IN BARREL RACE, LLC or Group W Productions, LLC may result in the disqualification of the contestant, with no refund of entry fees. The contestant may also be placed on the ineligible list for future ALL IN BARREL RACE events. These acts may include but are not limited to the following:

- ★ Using abusive or intemperate language or attempting to threaten, bribe, influence, or harass any contestant, spectator, staff member, or arena personnel.
- ★ Also, any remarks made with the intent to cast aspersions on the character or integrity of a staff or management member.
- ★ Moving or attempting to move markers at any time.
- ★ Use of electronic and/or remotely controlled devices to alter the outcome of a run.
- ★ Abuse of a horse in any way either on the ground or in the saddle. No whipping a horse from the ground by a bystander.
- ★ Any Abuse of an animal in the show arena and/or evidence that an act of abuse has occurred prior to or during the exhibition of a horse in the competition.

- ★ Arena Access ONLY during scheduled times, any access outside of these times is subject to disqualification.
- ★ Competing while under the influence of drugs or alcohol.
- ★ Misidentifying a horse in any ALL IN BARREL RACE barrel class.
- ★ Misidentifying a rider in any ALL IN BARREL RACE class.
- ★ Other conduct that is not in the best interest of ALL IN BARREL RACE, LLC, Group W Productions, LLC, or its contestants.
- ★ Failure to make good on a returned check to ALL IN BARREL RACE or to any other association which has a cooperative agreement with ALL IN BARREL RACE on the returned checks.
- ★ ALL IN BARREL RACE at their sole discretion shall have the authority to disqualify or deny entry to any horse they deem dangerous to the rider, or to other individuals, animals, or property.

SAFETY

Safety is a prime objective at this barrel race. If you have a horse that could be dangerous to yourself, other contestants, or other horses, DO NOT come to this barrel race. Any horse or contestant deemed to be dangerous by the management of ALL IN BARREL RACE, LLC or Group W Productions, LLC will be disqualified and entry fees will not be refunded.

RULES AND POSTPONEMENT OF EVENT

The management of ALL IN BARREL RACE reserves the right to create any new rule, or modify any existing rule, in order to better the sport or this barrel race. Rules are posted at lvbarrelrace.com.

ALL IN BARREL RACE reserves the right to adjust, change, or modify any rule, format, payout, or element that is deemed affected by any uncontrollable circumstance that may affect the event.

Corrections of times and results are the responsibility of both barrel secretary and contestant and to make known any error or mistake made by either secretarial or contestant. Any intentionally dishonest act will result in disqualification.

ALL Changes must be made by the Secretary's office.
